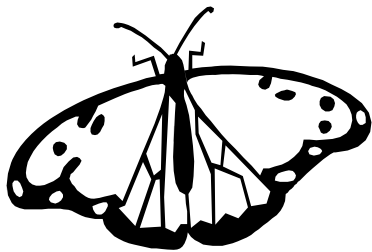

More Butterfly Lessons

When I was a child, for many years I collected butterflies and moths. I used to spend days in the meadows watching and hunting for the different kinds and I would read about them in books and learn their names. I still love to watch and identify them but no longer would I wish to capture them or kill them just so I could put them in a box in my collection.

There are many things about nature that you do not learn in books but by watching the living things and seeing their different ways. People who only learn from books or in classrooms miss most of the precious lessons God seeks to teach us in the lives of His creatures.

There is a beautiful butterfly called a 'Question Mark'. Its strangely shaped wings reminded someone of that punctuation I guess. When its wings are closed it looks like a withered brown leaf but when it opens them you see a lovely bright orange with spots and spangles and a violet edging. It is most lovely.

It likes to sip the juice from rotting fruit and so can sometimes be seen under trees where ripe fruit has fallen to the ground. In my experience I found it one of the hardest butterflies to ever capture and

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I think I only managed to catch one of them.

I'll tell you why. When danger threatens the average butterfly, it will flutter up and fly around and around and will usually return to the same spot if the danger seems to be gone. So if a hunter stays very still, most butterflies come back and land right in front of you, and you can easily catch them in your net. I became very good at staying still and waiting.

Now the Question Mark is very different! If you are going to catch him, you have to see him quickly and catch him before he sees you, because as soon as he sees danger he immediately takes off and flies quickly up into the sky and seldom returns. If he returns even once, he is very nervous, and if he sees danger again--he is GONE.

I have thought about Satan's tricks and traps. He is trying to catch all of us and put us in his collection and then say to Jesus, "Ha, Ha! I got this one away from You; this one will never be in heaven with You! See? Here they are; pinned under my control!"

Now Jesus told His people to watch out for Satan's tricks. He told us many ways we can see that a thing is not good and He says we are to get away quickly and leave wrong things alone, so we

won't be caught.

But most people are not smart as the Question Mark, when he sees danger; he's out of there! Most people see the danger signs that a thing is not good and yet they say, "Oh, it's only a small thing" and "I can stop any time I want to", or "Oh, I'm not really bothered by this, it won't hurt me." And first thing you know you are captured by Satan and pinned in one of his collections. Maybe smoking cigarettes gets you, or alcohol. Maybe it is video or computer games or TV and Movies that capture your mind.

I urge you to take a lesson from the Question Mark, the minute your conscience warns that some situation or activity is not what Jesus wants you to do – get away from it fast, and don't come back!

HISTORY OF HALLOWEEN

1 Corinthians 10:20,21 "But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils. Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils."

With the loving approval of their parents, children dress up in weird costumes and play pranks on Halloween night, little realizing that for over a thousand years this one evening in the year has been specially dedicated by spirit mediums and witches to the worship of Satan.

Halloween has nothing to do with Christianity. It is a festival which no one, child or adult, should have anything to do with. We need to better understand the origins of Halloween and its dangers.

October 31st was celebrated by the Druids with many human sacrifices and a festival honoring their sun god and Samhain, the lord of the dead. (Both are really Satan) They believed that the sinful souls of those who died during the year were in a place of torment, and would be released only if Samhain was pleased with their sacrifices.

Irish records tell of the fascination the Catholic monks had with the powerful Druids, and Druids soon became important members of their monasteries. Pope Gregory the Great decided to bring the Druids' holiday into the church.

Pope Gregory III moved the church festival of

October 31st to November 1st and called it All Hallows or All Saints' Day. Pope Gregory IV decreed that the day was to be kept by the church. The term Halloween comes from All Hallows Eve.

The founding fathers of America refused to permit the holiday; because they knew it was a pagan holiday. Halloween was not widely celebrated in the U.S. until about 1900. In the 1840's there was a terrible potato famine in Ireland which sent thousands of Catholic Irish to America. They brought Halloween with them.

The modern custom of going from door to door asking for candy goes back to the time of the Druids. They believed that sinful, lost souls were released upon the earth by Samhain for one night on October 31st while they awaited their judgment. They were thought to come to the houses of the living. People greatly feared these spirits and thought that the spirits would harm and even kill them if the sacrifices they gave did not appease Samhain. They carved demonic faces into pumpkins or large turnips, placing a candle in them to keep the evil spirits away from their homes.

Yet such teachings did not help the people. Throughout Europe, on this one night of the year, it soon seemed as if all the devils came out! Indeed, that was the hidden meaning of Halloween, and the wild excitement and orgies of the people on that night seemed to fulfill it. We are seeing more and more attention paid to this holiday every year. Why? Because people are moving further away from God and His Holy Spirit is being withdrawn from the earth. They fool themselves into thinking they can be saved by Jesus and yet celebrate with the devil! We either are 100% the Lord's, or we aren't His at all.

The Druids believed that on Halloween, ghosts, spirits, fairies, witches, and elves came out to harm people. These evil creatures must be placated with offerings of food. The Celts would go with their children to one another's house to gather food for the devil gods. This is the most dangerous "holiday" in the year. For long ages, Halloween has been a night especially dedicated to satanic agencies.

Every October 31 we see the clearest evidence of that fact. Vandalism on a major scale now plagues our cities on that night. A few years ago, Detroit alone experienced three days of riots, arson, and mass destruction. For three days children and adults seemed possessed, and the city seemed out of control.

Should we today celebrate this pagan night,

which every witch, clairvoyant, wizard, and spirit medium will tell you is the outstanding occult night in the year? It may seem like fun and games. You may be saying now, but we do not worship the devil and I see nothing wrong with it.

Well, don't forget that it is still "Satan's Holiday." Even if you are not 'serious' about it, Satan is! And He plays for keeps. If we take part in something that is Satan's, the holy angels cannot protect us, and he can take over our lives. If we take part in a Satanic holiday, *we are worshipping Satan* whether we think so or not!!

Few people realize how very dangerous it is to dabble in spiritualism. It may seem like innocent fun, but is it? Lets look at what God's Word says about it:

"When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee." Deuteronomy 18:9-12

The widespread problem of harmful substances such as razor blades, drugs, poisons, needles, etc. being placed in the Halloween treats is no accident. Testimonies of several ex-Satanists show that children killed and injured by the "treats" are sacrifices to Satan (or Samhain). Satanists throughout the world continue to perform human sacrifices on Halloween. Also many pets are tortured and killed, it is too horrible to even write about! Is this something you want to participate in?

I am going to be honest with you about this. If you really have given your heart to Jesus and want to be in heaven with Him and the holy angels, how can you still desire and enjoy the things of the devil, which represent death and destruction?

Stop and look at the kind of things done on Halloween, it all glorifies death and ugliness. Satan is the source of these things. Think of some of the horrible masks used on this night- would you want to really look like that? Just follow Satan and you will end up like that. Do you really want to be dead? Death and misery is all Satan will ever bring to his followers.

Jesus represents life and beauty, goodness and happiness. Satan only brings to us death, fear, pain and misery. Is it really fun to be scared? No, the Bible says 'Fear hath torment'. 1John 4:18. Dear readers, if Halloween still has any influence in your life, pray for forgiveness and ask Jesus to help you to see it as He sees it. TRUE-STORY-TIME

"NO DEVIL STRINGS" part 10 Joyous Jubilee and Sad Farwell

During the span of his lifetime Kata Rangoso saw few changes in the physical appearance of his lovely islands, so far removed from the mainstream of civilization. No great cities had sprung up, no superhighways roared with automobiles, no billowing clouds of industrial smoke blackened the tropical sky, and no television screens lured children from their canoes on the lagoon.

But the aging pastor did see changes that made his heart rejoice, changes in the lives of men. Schools and churches had replaced the skull houses in the jungle groves. The meeting places of the spirits were now overgrown with vines. His people no longer walked the forest trails in fear of enemy spears. Could any man ask to have lived to see more dramatic changes than these?

However, the noble tree that had withstood so many severe storms was now aging before its time. Undoubtedly the harsh treatment and floggings that Rangoso received during the war had sapped his otherwise boundless strength and energy.

The year 1964 would be the fiftieth anniversary of the coming of Captain G. F. Jones in the *Advent Herald*. Surely this should be a time of happy celebration for the Solomon Islands people. As his last act of great organization Kata Rangoso, now elderly, planned a special celebration for the joyous jubilee.

From his home, with the agreement of his mission president, Rangoso sent out directives to every corner of the territory. As the jubilee time drew near, the people were to meet at Batuna to take part in the largest gathering of Adventist believers ever in the Solomon Islands. Rangoso made a personal journey to Batuna to meet with tribal and church leaders to plan all facets of the celebrations, including the great task of housing and catering for such a group of people. Many extra

thatched huts must be built, and the supply of sweet potatoes, yams, and taro would be measured in tons.

News of the coming jubilee spread throughout the islands. Nothing would keep those away who lived within canoeing distance. From more remote areas church groups would send delegates, making sure to include island pioneers, those still living who had accepted Christianity under G. F. J ones.

Having left no coconut shell unturned in an effort to ensure that the celebrations would be a complete success, Kata Rangoso returned home. Then occurred a seemingly little thing that was to turn the hourglass for the last time.

With eyesight failing, Rangoso slipped on some steps at his home and injured his leg. He carried on with his work, making little mention of the incident; but doubtless because of his failing health, the wound refused to heal.

Meanwhile, the time for the giant jubilee camp meeting had come. Nearly two and a half thousand ebony Adventists arrived from their home villages on the various islands to take part in a celebration that would live long in their memories. A series of inspirational meetings had been planned, interspersed with music. Native choral groups presented forty-three special musical numbers, sung as only Solomon Islanders could sing them.

A highlight of the historic program was a colourful pageant in which pioneer island missionaries represented the islands to which they had carried the gospel so many years before. How the people thrilled as deeds of missionary valour were recalled. Many grey-haired delegates said that the health services brought to the Solomon Islands by the mission had greatly extended the life of the people. "In fact," they said, "if the mission had not come to us, we would have been dead long before this."

"It is remarkable," wrote the Union President, "that so many who accepted Christ when Pastor G. F. Jones first arrived in the Solomons should still be alive after fifty years. The presence of these men greatly enriched the grand occasion and inspired all who were there."

Another interesting link with the past was the presence at the session of Gango and Kusolo, two of Captain Jones's original crewmen on the mission ship.

Pastor H. White, guest speaker from the Australasian Division and onetime mission leader in the Solomons, reported: "In 1914 there was not

one Seventh-day Adventist in the Solomon Islands. Today one in every four persons in the western Solomons is a Sabbath School member, and one in every six is a baptized church member. Currently 110 of the western Solomons people alone are in mission service, many in far-flung and still primitive areas, following in the footsteps of their faithful forebears. What hath God wrought!"

But for the people of the islands, the "happy birthday" celebrations were tinged with sadness. Over the lagoon foreboding news came drifting in, Kata Rangoso, their beloved leader, lay seriously ill in a far-off hospital.

Rangoso felt very disappointed when he first realized that he could not attend the jubilee celebrations. He had contributed his finest effort, and he knew that the great gathering would be a happy and memorable one for his people.

Now as he lay helpless in his room, awaiting medical aid, he prayed for the grace and trust he would need in this bleak hour. Outside his window the sun glinted on glossy coconut fronds, and birds called in the high-limbed trees. He drifted into half sleep and dreamed of childhood days, of canoe races and fishing in the lagoon, of gathering nuts in the forest; things he would never do again.

A gentle knock sounded at his door, and missionary nurse Ellis Gibbons entered. Asked to examine the sick pastor, he soon discovered that Rangoso's leg was gangrenous. The patient must be taken to a hospital as soon as possible.

Arrangements were made to fly Pastor Rangoso to the Central Hospital, where doctors tried for several days to improve his general health to make surgery possible.

By October 12 it was decided that an amputation would be attempted, and Rangoso's younger brother, Jimaru, was called. His other relatives were also notified.

By now Kata Rangoso fully understood the seriousness of his condition. After his leg had been amputated, Pastor Rangoso lingered for another thirteen days. His ailing body had no strength to fight back. There were days when he could not speak. Several pastors visited and encouraged him before going on to the jubilee meetings.

Members of the sick man's family stayed in constant attendance. He was greatly cheered by many messages from near and far, from his own village people, from mission leaders, and from the president of the General Conference in the United States. He was aware that at the jubilee meetings

the people were praying for him.

Jimaru describes his last moments with his brother: "I said to him, 'How are you, Rangoso?' He put out his hand and slowly pulled my head down to his lips. He said these words: "Be strong in Jesus, you and all my brothers and my children and my people, and all who believe in the second coming of Jesus. I will meet you all again very soon." Then he held my hand as if to say good-bye." Shortly afterward Pastor Kata Rangoso drew his last breath. A man of valour, a spiritual leader, a prince of God, was at rest.

It was the day after the jubilee celebrations had finished. The people returning to their homes heard the news, and a flood of tears mingled with the salt waters of the lagoon. It was a depth of sorrow that will probably never be repeated in the Solomon Islands, for the people said, "He was our leader. There will never be another like him."

In 1954 when Kata Rangoso attended the General Conference of his church in San Francisco, he spoke to the people about missions: "I have heard some white people say, 'Why do missionaries go out to heathen people to interfere with their old ways? They are happy in their heathen customs.' Friends, those who are saying that kind of thing don't know what they are talking about. This truth has changed my life and the lives of my people, and we are happy.

"We want to say, Thank you very much for what you have done in the past in sending your money and sending your people to us to help in the work of God out there. I know that in the near future, when the Master shall come, you will be happy to meet some of the island people in the kingdom of God." = ^ .. ^ =

BUILDING FOR JESUS VOLUNTEERS

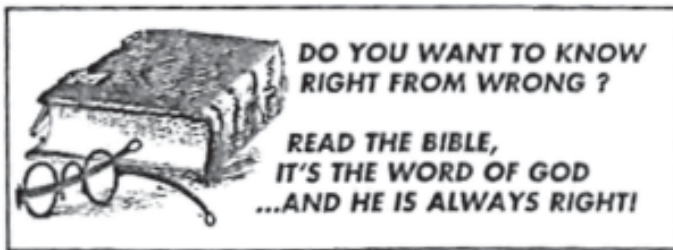
A call for loyal soldiers comes to one and all;

Year 1: 2nd Quarter: "MESSIAH OUR PRINCE" WEEKLY BIBLE LESSON 12: "JESUS IS COMING AGAIN: THE REAL AND THE COUNTERFEIT"

For our Bible lessons we are going to use the King James Version of the Bible. Just like the boys and girls used to use to learn to read from in the pioneer days.

There will be some texts to look up for each day and you should practice your memory verse until you can say it without looking. Don't forget to learn the text too.

MEMORY VERSE: "Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen." Revelation 1:7

Sunday

Text: 2 Thessalonians 2:9, 10 "Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved."

We know that Satan is going to try to appear as Jesus. He is going to come, and most of the people on earth will be fooled by him. Already there are demons pretending to be Jesus appearing to people. Devils are also appearing as 'Mary' and different heathen gods. It is important that we know how to tell the difference so we will not be fooled.

Notice in our text that it talks about the "Love of the Truth". This is so important, because only those who have it will be saved in these last days! I will still go to heaven even if I have sin that I

know about in my life.

Mary, and angels and spirits of the dead are from God, and I can talk to them.

The Law of God was done away with when Jesus died; I don't have to keep it.

The Spirit of Prophecy is out of date; I don't have to obey it.

It doesn't matter what I do, Jesus doesn't expect me to be like Him.

If people want to recognize a counterfeit piece of money, they always study the true. Christ's Second Coming has unique features that Satan cannot counterfeit. We must know them well so that we won't be deceived.

Thought - Dear students, we must 'love the truth' even if it seems hard to us, it's the only way to be saved.

Monday

Text: Matthew 24:27 "As the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be." Revelation 1:7 "Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him."

Well, most of us never see those people who claim to be Christ. So most certainly, they can't be!

No one will have to tell you when Jesus comes; you will see Him coming in the clouds. There are other signs the devil cannot duplicate. Wednesday

There is still more good news! Notice what happens to the righteous living at Christ's second coming! The Righteous Living are Caught up to Meet Jesus. The faithful followers of Jesus are caught up with the resurrected dead to meet the Lord in the air, what a happy reunion that will be for many families.

And All of the Saved Will Be Changed!

Paul gives us more details of what will happen when Jesus returns: "Behold, I show you a mystery; ... we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump; for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality." 1 Corinthians 15:51-53.

And there is something else God will give His people: "...We look for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ: who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto His glorious body." Philippians 3:20, 21.

A body like Christ's! No more aches or pains, or disease. What news could be more welcome?

Thought - God will give every follower of Jesus His gift of love, life everlasting. All other gifts are meaningless without this gift of immortality.

Thursday

Text: Revelation 6:14-17 "The heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, ... and the mighty men ... hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, 'Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sits on the throne ... For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?'"

There will be a Great Earthquake: "And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth." Revelation 16:18.

This earthquake will break down the cities of the earth at the coming of Christ. No one could possibly miss an earthquake like this, as it ushers in the coming of Christ!

Jesus warned that His coming would be at a time when no one was expecting it. In Matthew 24:30, we are told that when Jesus returns, "...all the tribes of the earth will mourn..." This is what Jesus said would happen to those who are not

ready for that day!

They are lost, and they know it! What a sad picture, when it could have been so different. Oh yes, that day will be real! There will be no waking up to find it was only a dream! Nothing is more important on earth, than being ready to meet Jesus when He comes.

Friday

Text: Revelation 16:14 "For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty."

Let's just review quickly.

1. False prophets and pretend christs will try to deceive everyone. The devil will try to personate an angel of light.
2. The second coming will not be secret.
3. Every eye will see Jesus coming.
4. All the holy angels will come with Jesus.
5. He will come with the blast of a trumpet.
6. He will come with a shout of the Archangel.
